

Our Intervention Locations

We have ongoing projects in Vadodara, Panchmahal, Dahej and ChotaUdepur districts in Gujarat and Palghar district in Maharashtra.

OUR OUTREACH:

- 4392 Rural farmers impacted through water conservation interventions.
- Agricultural training provided to 1145 women farmers in Naswadi under the Mahil Kisan Sashaktikaran Pariyojana Scheme.
- 144 Women Self Help Groups (SHGs) formed by 2020 with a total of 1536 members.
- 1273 SHG women engaged in income generation activities, average monthly income = Rs 5100 per month.

OUR OUTCOMES:

- 28475 sq.m. area covered and 290 lac litres water conserved due to our Farm ponds construction in Panchmahal and Rain water harvesting structures done in Palahar during 2019-20.
- 1609 acres covered through training farmers on Sustainable Agriculture.
- Installed Micro Irrigation Systems in partnership with farmers in Panchmahal.

Project Paripurna and Farmer Producer Companies (FPCs):

Deepak Foundation has initiated project 'Paripuma' with the support of Millennium Alliance and Deepak Group of Companies for 6000 marginal tribal women farmers in 88 villages of Kawant and Naswadi blocks of Chhota Udepur district in Gujarat. The project focuses on the key processes like product design of Instant Meal Mix, Community engagement and capacity building of FPCs. A total of 300 FPGs have been formed and around 5000 women will get direct benefit from the project.
