## COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY OBSTETRICS AND NEWBORN CARE (CEmONC) :

CEmONC has been functioning successfully since 2005-2006, leading to a reduction in the maternal and infant mortality in the region. It is providing free of cost emergency obstetrics and new born care services to the tribal population. Deepak Foundation, in partnership with the Govt. of Gujarat, implemented the unit that serves over 900,000 people from local tribes. As a part of this initiative, over 2,700 deliveries, out of which 600 were high risk involved.

The unit introduced laparoscopy services for conducting low risk and minimal invasive surgical procedures. It is also one of the first Community Health Centres in the tribal district of Gujarat to introduce such an advanced surgical procedure, which otherwise is available only at tertiary or private healthcare institutions.

### Our Presence:

This 102 bedded hospital serves as an important referral point of seeking medical care for patients referred from different Primary Health Centres (PHCs) in the Chota Udaipur district. Apart from the Chota Udaipur district, this centre also caters to the PHCs of the two blocks (Jambhughoda and Ghogambha) of Panchmahal district and Alirajpur district of Madhya Pradesh. In total it caters to around seven PHCs covering a tribal population of around nine lakhs.

## Objective:

To serve as a comprehensive emergency medical unit for maternal and newborn care for more than ten lakhs tribal population in tribal blocks of Chhota Udaipur and adjoining districts of Gujarat.

To avoid delay in treatment to emergency Obstetric and newborn cases referred from grassroots level and public health facilities. Provide timely referral of complicated cases to a tertiary level hospital (SSG, Vadodara- Medical college hospital).

## FACILITIES AVAILABLE:

### Gynecology:

- ANC and PNC care
- Normal and complicated Deliveries
- Round the clock emergencies met by trained obstetrician and staff nurse round the clock emergency treatment protocols, equipment and drugs are available in the casualty, labor room and new born care services
- Emergency USG taken for maternal emergencies
- Iron sucrose administration for severely anemic women
- Blood transfusion services
- Family planning services

### Other Facilities:

- Integrated Counseling and Testing Centre (ICTC) within the premises of the
- CHC-CEmONC in partnership with GSACS for integrated counseling and testing for HIV
- Biomedical waste management facility
- Linkages with Help Desk at SSG Hospital

1. Resuscitation of new born by trained pediatrician
2. Stabilization of critically ill new-born in New Born Stabilization Unit(NBSU)
3. Infant Young Child Feeding practices
