Celebrating 43 Years of Purpose and Progress :

The Deepak Foundation family gathered on October 2 to celebrate its 43rd Foundation Day. The event honoured a journey built on dedication and perseverance, focusing on the theme of "Reflecting on our roots, Renewing our commitment, and Rising to the promise of what lies ahead".



Healthcare Initiatives & Awareness



Cancer Awareness and Mammography Screening :
During Cancer Awareness Month 2025, a two-day camp provided doorstep access to mammography screening for early breast cancer detection in collaboration with the Rotary Club of Bharuch.



Sparsh Project at Vankaner :
A comprehensive health camp offered HPV vaccinations, mammography, general OPD services, and eye check-ups to bring essential healthcare to rural communities.



Inauguration of Women Health Services MHU at Dahej :
A new Mobile Health Unit (MHU) was launched to provide safe motherhood care, NCD screening (BP and diabetes), and adolescent anemia programs.

Maternal & Women's Health Camp at Dahej :
This initiative provided 73 OPD consultations and 62 USG referrals, ensuring early detection and continuity of care for women.

Sustainable Agriculture & Rural Development

Ravi Krishi Mahotsav in Morbi: Through the Sangaath project, the foundation guided farmers from Wankaner and Halvad talukas on how to access and benefit from various government schemes.



Solar Power for All: Lighting Up Villages: With support from Resonia Limited, solar street lights were installed across villages in Valsad, Navsari, and Surat to enhance safety for women and seniors.



Pulses Cultivation Training in Roha: In collaboration with KVK Roha, farmers were trained in organic techniques, efficient water management, and climate-resilient crop practices.



Education & Youth Inspiration

Wildlife Conservation Awareness on Children's Day: At Sanegaon Ashram School, 177 students learned about protecting natural habitats through a documentary and sessions led by Forest Department officers.



Science Exhibition was organised under Project Young Scientist where 129 students showcased 62 innovative models, such as earthquake alarms and water filtration systems, reflecting their scientific temper and problem-solving skills.



Inspiration through the "Sarang – Akash Ganga" Air Show: Over 65 children from Padaria and Kadodara witnessed an Indian Air Force display in Ankleshwar to ignite interest in aerospace and space education.



Education Vertical Boot Camp 2.0: A two-day residential camp at Shri Punit Ashram focused on "Learning, Reflection, and Action" to align the team with the foundation's 2030 roadmap was organized.



Children's Day Celebration with Wildlife Conservation Awareness



On the occasion of Children's Day, a Wildlife Conservation Awareness Session was organized by the Education Team of Deepak Foundation, Roha, with support from Forest Department officers. The session was conducted at Sanegaon Ashram School with the objective of educating students about the importance of wildlife conservation and the protection of natural habitats.

A total of 177 students from Project Vivek Vidya and Project Young Scientist (STEM) actively participated in the program. Four Forest Officials graced the occasion, sharing their knowledge and expertise with the students.

As part of the session, a documentary by the Forest Department was screened, offering students valuable insights into wildlife behaviour and conservation challenges. The officials also explained the threats posed by different snake species, essential safety measures, and the harmful impact of forest fires on animals and the ecosystem.

The activity successfully raised awareness among the children about wildlife protection, conservation practices, and the crucial role of responsible citizens in safeguarding the environment.

Project Sangaath Expansion to Sherkhi:



Project Sangaath has expanded its work area with the addition of Sherkhi village. To mark this, an Awareness Camp was organized to showcase the activities and performance of Project Sangaath, along with the branding and promotion of the Sangaath Rath and its integrated initiatives across livelihoods, education, and DMF facilities. With the presence of the Sarpanch, Deputy Sarpanch, Clerk, and VCE of Sherkhi Gram Panchayat, villagers were informed about various government welfare schemes and guided on the required documents (PRDs) needed to avail these benefits. The camp saw active participation from 55 community members, reinforcing the project's commitment to inclusive outreach and informed access to services.

In collaboration with the Horticulture Department of Gujarat, the foundation trained 55 women from Occhan village in food processing skills like making pickles, syrups, and jams. This initiative aligns with the vision for Atmanirbhar Bharat by enabling home-based entrepreneurship.



Millet Processing and Nutrition in Mokhada :

Under Project IVDP, 55 women from Nashera and Patherdi received hands-on training in preparing ragi satva and millet laddoos, reconnecting them with traditional grains for healthier meals and income opportunities.
